

Western Gray Squirrel (*Sciurus griseus*)

This squirrel is gray with white-tipped hairs. It has a long, bushy tail with bands of gray, white, and black. Gray squirrels are active all year. They feed on pinecones, acorns, some fungi, berries and insects. In the Central Valley, Western Gray Squirrels are mostly found in rural and foothill areas.
