## Out with the Old in with the New

It is hard to believe that Critter Creek Wildlife Station has been around for over 25 years! Many of the cages in the compound area are original cages made mostly of wood and wire. This past spring, our 25 year old conditioning/hunting cage finally defied repair. We had to tear it down. Next to it were two mews where we used to house our educational Great-horned owls. They were moved to more spacious accommodations a year ago, so those structures, too, were torn down. The need to replace the conditioning/hunting cage is crucial. We are able to prepare birds for release three times faster when this cage is rebuilt. The room the two mews took up was better utilized with a little planning. That area will house four very spacious mews with a convenient double entry. With the help of our volunteers these structures should be ready for the Winter Festival. It will give the compound area a whole new look.

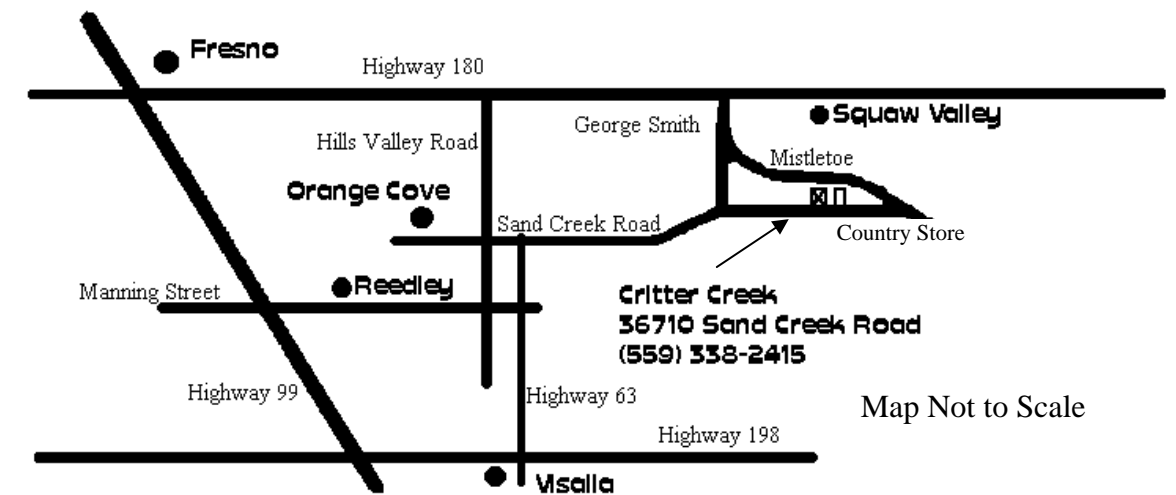
